Past President Duties -Tab #2

General

1. The Past President's duties are directed in the Legion Provincial Command By-Laws and are presented here. Additional points have been added based on the normal operations that have occurred over many years.

Appointment of the Past President

2. As per Provincial By-Laws, after the election of a new President in the May elections, the immediate previous President becomes the Past President commencing 1 June of that year and is in that position until another President is voted in. If for health reasons, or personal reasons, the immediate Past President cannot take on these duties, then the President must identify another previous President who may be willing to take on those duties and appoint them with the approval of the Executive.

General Duties of the Past President:

3. These are the responsibilities and general duties of the Past President:
- a. Be a member of the Executive Committee with the same powers as the other members.
 - b. Provide assistance and advise to the current executive because of their experience and knowledge as a President.
 - c. Accept appointment to a Chair of a Committee (s) as requested by the President provided that the Past President is willing and able to handle those duties.

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
